Homelessness... It Can Happen to You



Approximately 3.5 million people, 1.35 million of them children, are likely to experience homelessness in a given year. This number does not

include the number of homeless people who live on the street, stay with friends temporarily or are residing in other housing not tracked by local agencies.

To understand homelessness we must first realize how it happens. Homelessness results from a complex set of circumstances which require people to choose between food, shelter, health care and other basic needs.

Homelessness... What You Need to Know



Of our nation's homeless population, half are families with children. As school employees, we must understand our role in making sure homeless children

in our schools receive an education.

School is one of the few stable, secure places in the lives of homeless children and youth — a place where they can acquire the skills needed to help them escape poverty.

By understanding homelessness and what you can do to help, you can make a critical difference in the lives of homeless youth in our community.

Homelessness... Enrolling Homeless Students



More than half of the nation's homeless are children, most of whom are elementary age or younger. As school employees we must understand our

role in ensuring educational access for children experiencing homelessness.

As school secretaries you will likely be the first contact a family has when attempting to enroll a student in school. This video will guide school staff through the process of enrolling homeless students.
