TRANSPORTATION TRAINING CYCLES

Beginning Driver Course: White enrollment cards are issued to drivers when they enroll in a beginning class and the card expires 10 days after the completion of the Course. *Once a white card is issued to a student, they cannot be issued another one.*

Beginning School Bus Driver Course (BSBD): Yellow cards expire at the conclusion of the current training cycle which is on the odd year (this year 2007). Everyone who takes this course from 10/01/05 to 9/30/07 will have their yellow card expire 9/30/07 and will need to complete a Continuing Education Class (CEC) before 9/30/07.

Continuing Education Course (CEC) for Bus Drivers: Green cards expire every other year on the odd year (this year 2007). Every driver that is driving now with a green card will have that card expire 9/30/07 unless they take the current CEC class, at which time they will be issued a new card that will expire 9/30/09.

Supervisor Continuing Education Course: Salmon colored cards expire every other year on the even year. Supervisors that have taken the last supervisors course will have their cards expire 9/30/08.

Beginning Instructor Course: Buff colored cards expire every other year on the even year. The instructors who have taken the last refresher class will have their cards expire 9/30/08. These individuals will have to complete an update course in the summer of 2008 in order to receive a goldenrod card that will expire in 2010.

Continuing Instructor Course: Goldenrod cards will expire at the end of each continuing education course cycle on the odd year. The instructors that are currently teaching the CEC classes will have their cards expire 9/30/07.
